The Joan Mitchell Foundation provides emergency support to US-based visual artists working in the mediums of painting, sculpture, and/or drawing, who have suffered significant losses after natural or man-made disasters that have affected a region on a broad scale. Beginning February 17, 2020, the Foundation will be accepting applications from artists affected by Hurricanes Florence, Harvey, Irma, Maria, Dorian, and Michael; California wildfires; Puerto Rico earthquakes or other events of this nature or scale.
